



FIRST TIME NOMINEE SELECTED FOR TRANS TASMAN 55s TEAM



Gladstone's Master's player Terri Read nominated for Queensland Women's Masters Team in 2018 at the State Championships held in Townsville. Terri was selected in the Qld 55 #1 Team to play at the Nationals held in Busselton / Bunbury. Terri was then selected to play in the Trans Tasman Team at the Gold Coast in 2019 and was awarded joint Highest Goal Scorer for the Championships.

Terri became involved in hockey when she was probably about 10 years of age. For the next 10 years she played a goalkeeper, followed by a break from hockey for 15 years. On returning to the game at the age of 35, she played on the field and not in the box.
